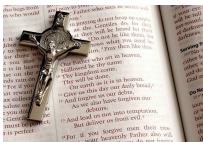

RE 	Definition: Unique Unique means one of a kind — someone or something that is special and different from everyone else. The Beatitudes – What They Are/Who matches the Beatitude

The Beatitudes are **8 blessings** that Jesus taught to help people live kindly, humbly, and with love.

They show how God blesses people who live in a good and caring way.

The 8 Beatitudes

1. **Blessed are the poor in spirit** – People who don't care about money because they have God.

Example: Someone who gives a lot of their money to charity.

2. **Blessed are those who mourn** – People who are sad will be comforted.

Example: A person grieving a loss who is supported by friends and family.

3. **Blessed are the meek** – Gentle people will be rewarded.

Example: Someone who is kind and calm, even when others are not.

4. **Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for what is right** – People who want fairness will be filled.

Example: Activists who stand up for justice and equality.

5. **Blessed are the merciful** – People who forgive others will be forgiven.

Example: A friend who forgives someone who hurt their feelings.

6. **Blessed are the pure in heart** – People who are honest and good will see God.

Example: Someone who always tries to do the right thing, even when no one is watching.

7. **Blessed are the peacemakers** – People who help others get along will be called children of God.

	<i>Example: A pupil who helps stop arguments and brings people together.</i> 8. Blessed are those who are treated badly for doing right – People who are brave and stand up for good will be rewarded. <i>Example: Someone who speaks out against bullying, even if it's hard.</i>
<u>Home Economics</u>	• All about food poisoning. • What temperatures do bacteria like the best? • Personal Hygiene. • How to store food correctly.
<u>History</u>	The 20th Century • The Sinking of the Titanic - was built by Harland and Wolff in Belfast, her maiden voyage (first journey) left from Southampton to New York in 1912, on that journey The Titanic hit an iceberg and sank in the early hours of the morning on 15th April 1912. There were 705 survivors and over 1500 people died. Newspaper had MIXED REPORTS on this early on. This is because accessing news was trickier then. • WW1 - 1914-1918, main trigger was the assassination of ARCHDUKE FRANZ FERNINDAD, The Triple Alliance consisted of Germany, Austria-Hungary, and Italy, while the Triple Entente was made up of France, Russia, and the United Kingdom. CONSCIENTIOUS OBJECTORS - someone who objects to serving in the army. You will be asked to name which countries have changed since then. • The Suffragettes - women could not vote until 1918. In 1903, a woman called EMMELINE PANKHURST and her daughters Christabel and Emmeline formed The Suffragettes. They interrupted parliament meetings, chained themselves to railings, and set postboxes on fire. • WW2 - 1939-1945, war was fought in Europe, Africa and Asia, allied

	countries were the British Empire, France, America, USSR. Nazi Germany led by Adolf Hitler. War started when Germany invaded Poland. Children who were sent away were evacuated. Germans bombing towns and cities in England was called The Blitz. ● Civil Rights Movement- a time in history when people in the USA worked together to make sure everyone was treated equally, no matter their skin colour. Happened mainly in the 1950s-60s. Martin Luther King: 'I Have a Dream' speech Rosa Parks: refused to give up her seat for a white person on a bus. She was arrested and lost her job for this but it put an end to segregation on buses. words to know - boycott= stop using. segregation= separate. campaign = planned activities to meet a goal.

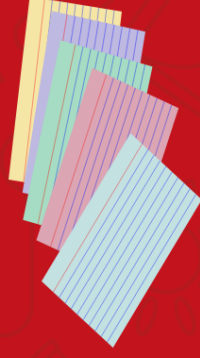

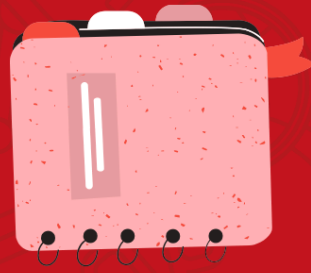
